

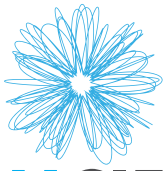

Students must meet the Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) skills standards for Certificate IV level study. Students may need to obtain a Working with Children (WWC) check (at their own expense), be at least 18 years of age and be an Australian citizen or permanent resident. People with disabilities are encouraged to apply subject to the person being able to undertake all tasks and requirements of the course.
