To receive this qualification, you must successfully complete **15 core plus 3 elective units** and **120 mandated work-placement hours**.

Delivery, assessment and course support

Delivered over **52 weeks** the approach to learning is blended, face-to-face for **8-hours per week**. Courses which are scheduled over summer may include **6 weeks holiday**. Assessments include case studies, group work, roleplays, short answer questions, practical demonstration and a work placement portfolio. Practice based training activities and tasks are conducted in simulated and workplace environments.

Work Placement

You are required to undertake **120 placement hours** in an approved aged care facility. MCIE is affiliated with Aged Care facilities throughout Melbourne and the outer regions. MCIE workplace coordinators will support you to gain and complete your work-placement.

Entry requirements

- Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) standards for Certificate IV level study
- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- be at least 18 years of age
- people with disabilities are encouraged to apply. Enrolment is subject to the person being able to undertake all tasks and requirements of the course.

Pre-requisites and industry requirements

There are no pre-requisite requirements for this qualification. You must have a National Police Check and First Aid to participate in Work-placement and Working with Vulnerable People Check.

Prior learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and Credit Transfer (CT) are available to eligible students. RPL applications are subject to fees.
