Course structure

To gain this qualification you must successfully complete **9 core** plus **1 elective unit**, and undertake **12 practical-placement hours**.

Elective units have been chosen by MCIE based on industry consultation and feedback.

Job outcomes and pathways

Potential job outcomes depend on individual aims and other higher education qualifications held. For example, combined with an Australian Bachelor's degree in any field, this qualification could lead to employment at:

- private English language colleges,
- community and migrant centres,
- English language schools overseas, and
- private tutoring

MCIE recommends contacting individual institutions for information about required qualifications for their English language teachers.

Delivery, assessment and course support

Delivered over **26 weeks** of blended learning that includes **6 hours per week** face-to-face training, **5 hours** self-paced study (this will depend on prior experience and educational background), and class practicums to support course outcomes. Courses scheduled over summer, may include **6 weeks' holiday**.

Assessment takes a variety of forms and includes written short answer questions, teaching practicum in real classroom settings, and observation of experienced TESOL teachers.

Practical Placement

12 practical placement hours in English language classes.

Your trainer will support you to complete the compulsory practical component of the course.
