## **Delivery, assessment and course support**

Delivered over 12-14 months in the work place (full-time employment)

All trainees are provided with a designated trainer who will devote 1:1 instruction and guidance throughout their traineeship journey. The specialist MCIE Traineeship Industry Liaison works collaboratively with the trainee and employer to ensure program is fit for purpose and each party is supported throughout.

Assessments include case studies, roleplays, short answer questions, practical demonstrations and a work-based training logbook and portfolios.
