Course structure

15 core and 2 elective units are delivered over 12 months.

- · 48 weeks of delivery
- 4 weeks of holidays
- 160 hours work placement

Delivery and assessment

This 12 month program is delivered as blended training, both in-person and remotely in real-time via Microsoft Teams, for approximately 7.5 hours per week, with up to 5 hours trainer-directed learning each week.

This course is also available as a traineeship for domestic (local) students.

Assessments include case studies, group work, roleplays, written short answer questions, practical demonstrations, and a work-placement portfolio.
