Course structure

12 core and 3 elective units are delivered over a minimum of 52 weeks

- 46 weeks of delivery
- 6 weeks of holidays
- 280 hours work placement

Total course duration can vary depending on student progress.

Delivery and assessment

Delivered over 12 months in the work place (full-time employment).

All trainees are provided with a designated trainer who will devote 1:1 instruction and guidance throughout their traineeship journey. Assessments include case studies, roleplays, short answer questions, practical demonstrations and a work-based training logbook and portfolios.

Eligibility for government funded place

Entry requirements

- Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- Be at least 18 years of age
- People with disabilities are encouraged to apply.
- Candidates must be enrolled in the Early Childhood Education & Care setting to enrol in this course. To enter as a trainee, the trainee must enter a formal training contract

Entry into this qualification is open to individuals who hold either a CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education & Care or CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education & Care.
