To receive this qualification, you must successfully complete 6 core units, plus 6 elective units over 52 weeks.

Delivery and assessment

Traineeships allow students to earn and learn, they use their workplace experience to support the development of their skills.

Delivered over 52 weeks using a blended approach to learning, face-to-face for 3-hours per month and a 4-hour half day tutorial which is optional. When delivery occurs over the summer break the course includes 6 weeks holiday.
