

Course structure

Delivered over **9 months** with **7 core** plus **6 elective** units and **120 mandated work-placement hours**.

- 36 weeks of delivery
- 4 weeks if delivery is over summer holidays
- 120 hours work placement

Total course duration can vary depending on the individual's existing knowledge, experience and commitments.

Delivery and assessment

- Hybrid delivery: In real-time both face-to-face or remotely via Microsoft Teams
- 5 hours classes, 2.5 hours tutorials per week
- Online resources and assessments completed via an LMS

Total course duration can vary depending on the individual's existing knowledge, experience and commitments. MCIE can organise your work placement with one of our host employers if required.

Assessments include case studies, group work, roleplays, written short answer questions, practical demonstrations, and a work-placement portfolio. Practice-based training activities and tasks are conducted in a simulated environment only where they cannot be achieved within the workplace.

Work placement

Students must complete 120 mandatory placement hours for the work-based training component of this program. The MCIE Work Placement Coordinator will organise a local placement for you with one of our host employers or will support you in organising your own.
