Academic requirements

Completion of schooling equivalent to Australian Year 11 or higher.

English language proficiency requirements

Candidates must meet one of the following English Language proficiency requirements:

- IELTS band score of 5.5 or equivalent internationally recognised exam result in line with DHA regulations satisfactorily completing ELICOS at Upper Intermediate level from a NEAS endorsed English Training Centre
- Completion of secondary studies equivalent or higher to an Australian Year 12 qualification from an English-speaking country completion of MCIE English Placement Test with an overall score of 5.5 or above other tests like PTE, TOEFL and OET are also considered equivalent for direct entry into MCIE VET courses.

Candidates who have completed 1 year of study in Australia in English within the past 2 years at Certificate IV or AQF level 4 and above are exempt from submitting Australian Year 12 completion certificate or equivalent and Evidence of English Proficiency.

Other entry requirements

Regulatory

Candidates require a current and valid passport and valid study visa which covers the duration of the course.

Age at Commencement:

MCIE does not accept overseas students who will be under 18 years of age at the time of proposed commencement. the time of proposed commencement.

Course delivery & assessment

This program is delivered over **2.5 days per week**, both in-person and remotely, but no more than 30% remotely, with assessments and resources online via the Learning Management System.

Assessment for this program includes written tasks, long and short answer questions, multiple choice quizzes, group tasks, oral presentations, role plays, scenarios, case studies, work placement journals, logbooks, portfolios and projects. Most assessments are submitted online via an LMS.

Work-placement

Students must complete **280 mandatory placement hours** for the work-based training component of this program. The MCIE Work Placement Coordinator will organise a local placement for you with one of our host employers or will support you in organising your own.
