Course structure

To receive this qualification, you must successfully complete 13 core plus 4 elective units and 100 mandated work-placement hours, delivered over 36 weeks (38 sessions). 4 weeks holiday.

Delivery and assessment

Delivered over 9 months online and at MCIE campuses. Work-placement at an MCIE approved centre & MCIE can organise your work-placement with one of our host employers if required.

Assessment for this program includes written tasks, long and short answer questions, multiple choice quizzes, group tasks, oral presentations, role plays, scenarios, case studies, reflective journals, logbooks, portfolios and projects. Most assessments are delivered online via the Canvas LMS.
