Course structure

15 units are delivered over 47 weeks of training for a total duration of 52 weeks

- . 46 weeks of classroom delivery
- 3 weeks work placement 4 days per week for 30 hours for a total of 90 hours
- 5 weeks holidays

Delivery and assessment

Delivered over 12 months with 7 core plus 8 elective units and 90 mandated work-placement hours. 47 weeks of delivery 5 weeks if delivery is over summer holidays. 80 hours work placement.

Total course duration can vary depending on the individual's existing knowledge, experience and commitments. This program is delivered both in real-time at MCIE's campus and remotely with 5 hours classes and 2.5 hours tutorials per week. Assessment for this program includes written tasks, long and short answer questions, group tasks, oral presentations, role plays, scenarios, work placement journals, logbooks, portfolios and projects. Most assessments are submitted online via an LMS.
