## Delivery and assessment

This qualification consists of 10 units delivered in 36 class-based sessions for 5 hours each. plus 2.5 hours tutorials and one 6-week placement block of 7.5 hours per day, 2 days a week for a total of 90 placement hours over 36 weeks.

Total course duration for each student may vary according to the individual's existing skills, knowledge and work commitments.

## Work placement

You are required to undertake $\mathbf{9 0}$ placement hours in a disability care work-placement. MCIE is affiliated with many services for people with disability and will support you throughout your work-placement.
