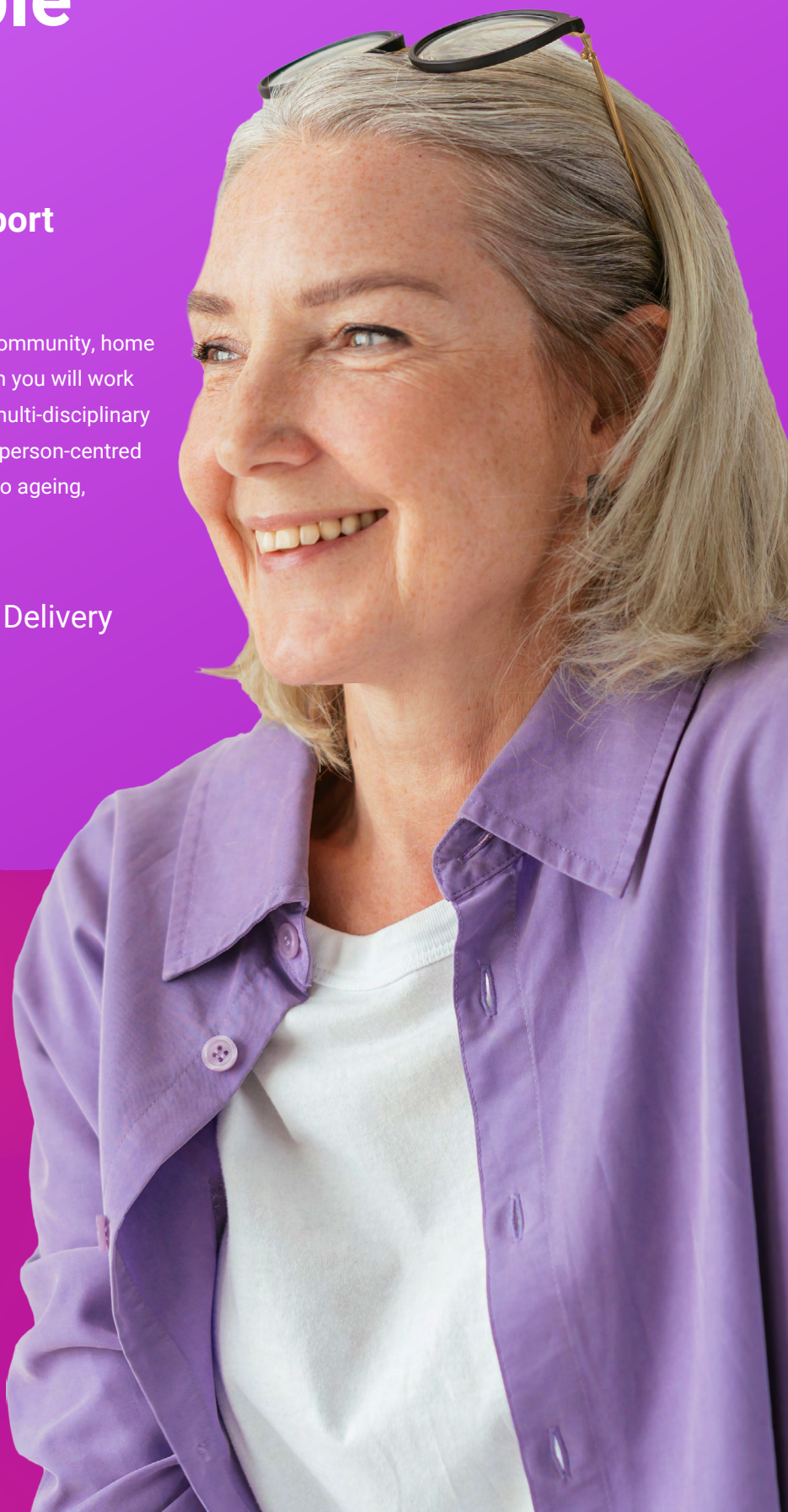

Course structure

Delivered over **9 months** with **9 core** and **6 elective units** are delivered over **36 weeks**

- 36 weeks duration
- 10 weeks holidays
- 26 weeks delivery
- 120 hours work placement

Delivery and assessment

- Hybrid delivery: In real-time both face-to-face or remotely via Microsoft Teams
- 2 x 7.5 hours classes (15 hours per week)
- 2.5 hour tutorials per week
- Online resources and assessments completed via an LMS

Total course duration can vary depending on the individual's existing knowledge, experience and commitments. MCIE can organise your work placement with one of our host employers if required.

Assessments include case studies, group work, roleplays, written short answer questions, practical demonstrations, and a work-placement portfolio. Practice-based training activities and tasks are conducted in a simulated environment only where they cannot be achieved within the workplace

Pre-requisites

There are no pre-requisite requirements for this qualification. You must have a National Police Check and First Aid to participate in work-placement and Working with Vulnerable People Check.

Work placement

Students must complete **120 mandatory placement hours** for the work-based training component of this program. The MCIE Work Placement Coordinator will organise a local placement for you with one of our host employers or will support you in organising your own.
