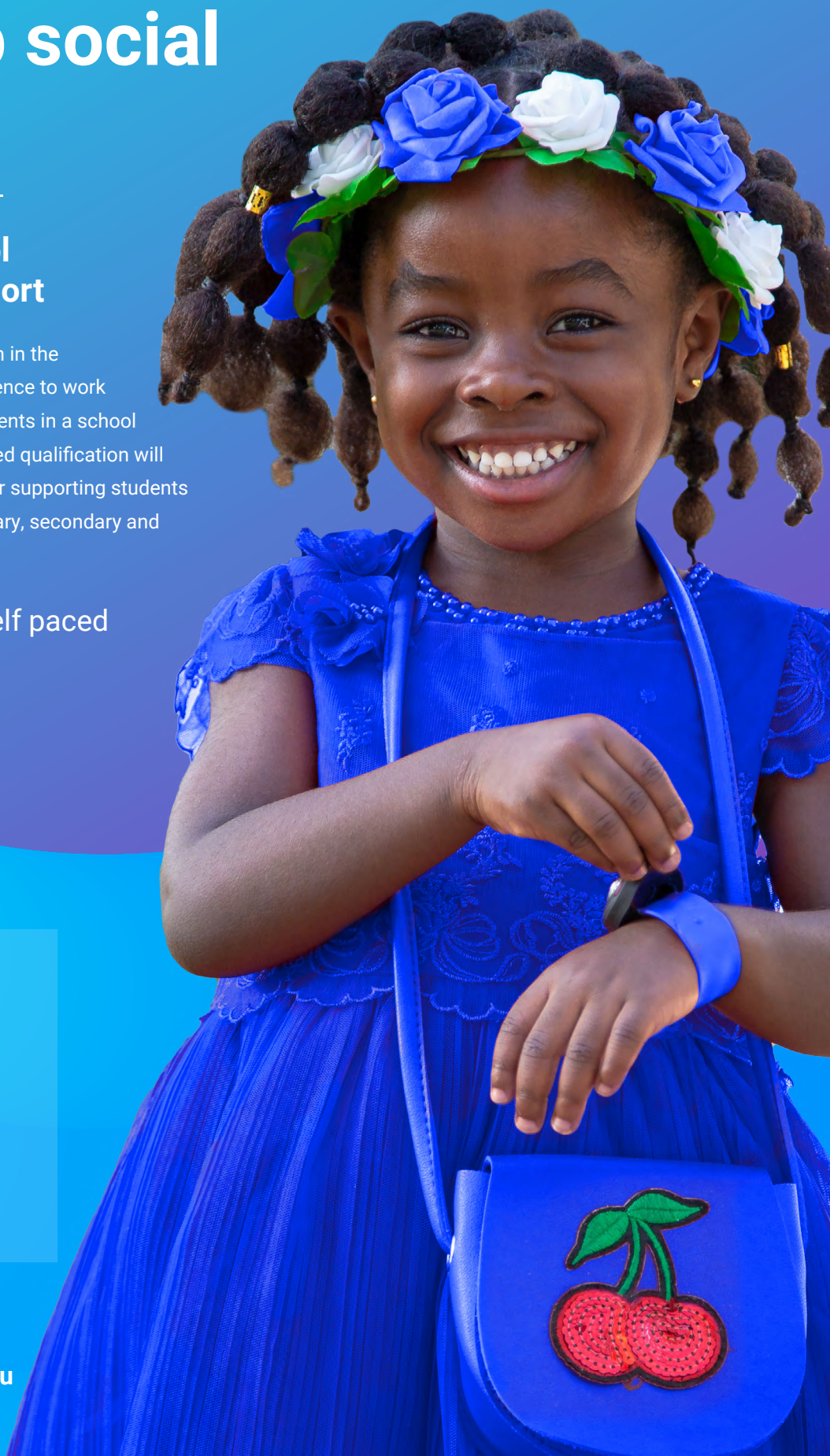

Course structure

- The course consists of 17 units, 13 core units, and 4 electives to be completed over 33 weeks.
- Studying for the Certificate IV in School Based Education Support is flexible and can be tailored to suit your needs and time commitments. The course is broken down into two parts: Online Theory and Work Placement.

Delivery and assessment

Course is accessed online via our user friendly learning management system. Assessments include written short answer questions, case study/scenario and practical demonstrations and work placement portfolio and reflective journal.

Student support

3 hours real-time facilitator led support webinars are available for students weekly. Students may access an optional 1 hour, one-on-one trainer session per month.

Digital technology

Students must have access to a computer or laptop and have sufficient digital literacy skills to access online content, enter answers to written questions, attach and upload documents, communicate with trainers via email, the student portal and the learning management system.

For the online part of the course, you'll need regular access to:

- **Computer:** Laptop or desktop computer with working speakers or headphone points.
- **Internet:** High-speed internet
- **Windows:** Operating system – Windows 8 or above.
- **MAC:** Operating system - OS X 10.14 Mojave or later.
- **Internet browser:** Google Chrome or Microsoft Internet Explorer 11.
- **Software:** Flash, Adobe Reader, Microsoft Word (or Open Office, which is free to download).
- **Office equipment:** Printer and scanner to print and upload some of your assessments.
- **Mobile phone with video capability or video camera:** Some assessments in your course may require you to take real-time videos of you undertaking tasks for assessment in front of an MCIE assessor.

Work placement information

Work placement is 19 weeks. There is a mandatory work placement of 100 hours for the completion of this qualification.

MCIE can organise your work placement for a \$300 fee if required.
